Wheelchair Trishaw Demo and rides

If you have been a pilot or a bike buddy at either of our long-term care facilities (Idlewyld and St. Peter's) you will have seen that some of the residents who wished to ride were unable to because they could not transfer from their wheelchairs to the trishaw. Van Raam makes another kind of trishaw called the Velo Plus, pictured below. The controls are the same as our current trishaws but the platform tilts to allow the passenger's wheelchair to be rolled up onto the bike.



Please sign up as a bike buddy or pilot on September 23 at Idlewyld (am) and St. Peter's (pm) so you can try the bike and see how the passengers like it. Cora, from Hamilton Trike will be bringing the bike over and showing us how to use it. If the signup is full, please come anyway, we'll try to give everyone a turn.
